## **PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO MBBS COURSE FOR THE YEAR 2017-18**

### Mission

We strive to

#### 1. Introduction:

1.1 KMCT Medical College is established in the year 2008 at Manassery-P.O, Makkam, Kozhikode, Kerala. The College has received final Recognition status for 100 seats of MBBS course as per Central Government Gazette notification No.U.12012/357/2006-ME(P-II) dated 31<sup>st</sup> October 2013. Letter of permission for the increase of seats from 100 to 150 from the academic year 2016-17 is obtained from Government of India and the Medical Council of India had recommended to Central Government for renewal of permission for the academic year 2017-18. Profile of the institution is attached as annexure I.

1.2 This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to the MBBS Course, against sanctioned intake for the academic year 2017-18, in the college, to be filled up by the College, including 15% NRI seats set apart for the dependents of Non Resident Indians. KMCT medical college is a muslim minority status institution. Muslim minority status certificate is issued by government of India, national commission for minority institutions dated 27.10.2009.

1.3 The conditions in this Prospectus, including fee structure, allocation and reservation of seats are subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the competent authority or Hon'ble Courts of Law. The number of seats, allocation of seats under various quota, fee structure may also change subject to conditions to any consensual agreement that may be signed between Government of Kerala and the college. Admission is made as per the

- Regulations of Medical Council of India as applicable to MBBS course. Fifteen percent (15%) of total seats are reserved under NRI quota.
- 1.4 Duration of the Course is 5 years and 6 months including a compulsory rotating internship of 12 months
- 2. Criteria of Eligibility for Admission.**
- 2.1 Nationality: Candidates must be Citizens of India or Dependents of Non-Resident Indians, or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI). For the purpose of admission, citizens of other countries will also be eligible, subject to approval from Central Government.
  - 2.2 Qualification:
    - 2.2.1 Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or any other examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with a pass in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English individually, and obtained minimum 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology, and minimum 50% separately for Biology/Bio-Technology, are eligible to apply for admission.
    - 2.2.2 In addition, they must have qualified in the NEET-UG-2017 for admission to MBBS course conducted by CBSE and they should obtain 50 percentile in the entrance examination
    - 2.2.3 In respect to candidates belonging to Scheduled-Castes, Scheduled Tribes and OBC will have a relaxation in the marks of qualifying examination and entrance examination as prescribed by the Medical Council of India MBBS course Regulation. The minimum marks obtained in the entrance Examination shall be 40 percentile instead of 50 percentile.
    - 2.2.4 In respect to candidates with locomotive disability of lower limbs, the minimum marks in qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology taken together in qualifying examination shall be 45 percentage instead of 50 percentage.
    - 2.2.5 Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of the qualifying examination from the Affiliating University, Kerala University of Health Sciences.
  - 2.3 Candidates should possess certificate of good conduct and character issued from the Institution last studied.
  - 2.4 Age: Applicants should have completed 17 years of age as on the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017. No relaxation in age will be allowed. There is no upper age limit.

### 3 Admission Procedure:

3.1 Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide various judgments, has upheld the rights of self financing Colleges having minority status to admit 100% seats, fixing fees etc in their institutions. The College is a Muslim Minority Institution and it is entitled to admit the students without entering into an agreement with the Government of Kerala. It is also having the provisions under Articles 19 (i) (g), 21 (2), 26 (2) and 30 (1) of the Constitution of India to its aid.

#### Seat matrix

(A) General Category	: 85% of total Seats (127 seats)
(B) Dependants of Non-Resident Indians	: 15% of total Seats (23 seats)

Reservation pattern in the General category:

(a) General Merit-	51 seats
(b) Community Quota (Muslims from Kerala)*-	26 seats
(c) Community Quota (Muslims From Malabar region)**-	25 seats
(d) Community Quota (All India Muslims from other than Kerala)***-	25 seats

\* If sufficient candidates are not available in this category, the candidates from general category will be considered

\*\* If sufficient candidates are not available in this category, the candidates from muslim community in the Kerala will be considered

\*\*\* If sufficient candidates are not available in this category, the candidates from muslim community in the Malabar region of Kerala will be considered

Note: The details of documents to be submitted to avail the reservation in community quota and the name of the authority to issue such documents will be notified later.

3.2 N.R.I. SEATS: 15% seats are earmarked for children and "dependents" of non-resident Indians, selected on inter se merit from the application received from NEET eligible candidates. The eligibility to get admission in the NRI quota may be changed as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court / High Court of Kerala if any.

3.3 The definition of "dependant" for NRI quota admission, is a candidate depend upon his/her father/mother/brother/sister/husband/wife/brothers and sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of father or mother/half brother/half sister/adopted father or adopted mother working abroad. Entire process relating to the sponsorship by a NRI shall be completed with all supporting documents before the cut-off date for admission.

4. Submission of Application Form:

- 4.1 The application will be invited by the Government of Kerala/ Government of India/management or the authority designated by them subject to the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.

NRI candidates seeking admission should have following documents

- o Sponsorship certificate
- o Attested Copy of the passport of the sponsor
- o Attested copy of the relevant pages of the passport where the employment visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate should be attested by the Indian embassy or consulate
- o Relationship certificate from the village officer

5 Fees

- 5.1 The annual tuition fee is Rs. 1500000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakh only) for the management quota and Rs.2000000 (Rupees Twenty Lakh only) for NRI quota. The tuition fee should be paid on 1<sup>st</sup> August of each year, irrespective of number of years of course duration. No concession in fee or exemption from payment of fees will be allowed to any candidate. Tuition fee is payable for five years in the entire duration of the course. In addition, the student is entitled to remit an interest free refundable deposit equivalent to the one year tuition fee at the time of admission. Candidates shall ensure payment of Tuition fee for the remaining four installments by way of a Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank covering payment of Fees on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018, 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019, 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020, and 1st August 2021.
- 5.2 In addition to above, each student shall be entitled to remit caution deposit, admission fee, fees payable by the Institution to the University, Medical Council of India, Government and other statutory bodies, transportation charges, examination conducting expenses, extra-curricular and establishment charges, which shall be specifically listed out and published each year on the notice board.
- 5.3 The candidates are required to undergo internship training at the end of Course as per Medical Council of India Regulation. During the internship period, the Institution will pay an allowance of Rs. 7000/- per month. Interns shall pay for campus accommodation charges at the prevailing rate for hostel accommodation.
- 5.4 The candidates admitted will not be granted NOC/permission for transfer to other Institutions during the course of study. (Order No. ACII/1795/Regulations/KUHS/2011 dated 22-12-2011 of the Registrar, Kerala University of Health Science).

5.5 Once admitted, the annual installment of fees for entire course duration shall be paid by the candidate, irrespective of the fact that the student is promoted or detained or discontinued. Failed/detained students are required to pay fee towards additional Tuition and establishment charges, hostel charges and University Examination charges as fixed by the institution.

## 6 Procedure of Selection

Admission of candidates will be conducted by the authority which has been authorized by the Government of Kerala/Government of India subject to the rules and regulations specified by the Medical Council of India. Admission will be made on inter-se merit, taking into consideration the reservation for various categories.

## 7 Allotment & Counselling

7.1 The allotment process of the selected candidates will be conducted as per the schedule notified by the authority which has been authorized by the Government of Kerala/Government of India subject to the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court of Kerala

7.2 Documents in original to be produced at the time of Admission:

- Admit card of NEET-UG-2017
- Rank/Mark List of NEET-UG-2017
- Mark list of the candidate at the qualifying examination (Plus two or equivalent).
- Pass Certificate of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- SSLC or equivalent of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
- Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE / ISCE.
- Migration certificate
- Nativity certificate
- A Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format obtained from a Medical Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon.
- Course and conduct certificate from the institution last studied.
- Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last studied.
- Originals of other certificates, the copies of which are enclosed with the application form.
- Income certificate issued by competent authority
- Document/ certificate required in proof of any benefit claimed in the application form for reservation in community quota<sup>#</sup>
- Bank guarantee from a nationalized/ scheduled bank for the amount of fee to be paid for the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> installments.
- Candidates selected for NRI quota seats should submit the following certificates at the time of admission

- Sponsorship certificate
- Attested Copy of the passport of the sponsor
- Attested copy of the relevant pages of the passport where the employment visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate should be attested by the Indian embassy or consulate
- Relationship certificate from the village officer

Note: Candidates are entitled to submit any documents in addition to the above as directed by the authority which has been authorized by the Government of Kerala/Government of India for the admission process.

7.3 Candidates will not be given any extension of time to produce the original documents, certificates and/or for payment of fees or for production of bank guarantee.

#### 8 Redressal of Grievances

Any complaint regarding rank list, allotment, eligibility for reservation, may be addressed in writing, to the Principal of the College prior to starting allotment process. The candidates are advised to obtain a receipt or acknowledgement with seal from the office of Principal of the College on submission of any complaint, which shall be duly corrected. Any complaints or grievances after the closure of admission, as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, will not be entertained. The Grievance if any will be intimated to Admission Supervisory Committee for their redressal.

#### 9 Caution Against Ragging:

According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do. All will have to abide by the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court of India, dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No.(s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principal's, College, Kerala & Ors [with SLP (C ) No.24296-99/2004 & W.P.(Crl) No.173/2006 & SLP (C ) No.14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Honorable Supreme Court of India or effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions.

In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/ she indulged in ragging, admission may be

refused or he/ she shall be expelled from the educational institution. Each of the student of the institution and his/ her parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration/ admission in prescribed format, which is mandatory for registration/ admission. Such an undertaking shall be submitted before the commencement of every academic year. An undertaking similar to the above shall be submitted every year by the student who is admitted to the hostel.

10 Refund/Adjustment of Fees

No request to refund of fees received will be entertained after the commencement of classes. If any candidate discontinues the course or leaves the Institution after closing date of admission, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the entire duration of the course. In all such cases Transfer Certificate and other certificates will be issued only after payment of liquidated damages and bank guarantees submitted will be cashed.
